## **REACH**

The European Union (EU) has adopted regulation

On no.1907/2006, also known as the EU REACH (Registration, Evaluation and Authorization of Chemicals) regulation, which became effective in June 2007.

Under the terms of the REACH regulations, the electronic components that we distribute (primarily semiconductors, passive products, and electromechanical parts) are referred to as 'Articles' as defined in REACH.

Isotrading has verified this regulation to the best of its knowledge, and we believe none of the articles that we sell intentionally contain any of the Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC's) currently on the candidate list in concentrations of >0.1% by weight.

Registration is required for companies that either produce or import into the EU any substance in volumes that exceed one ton per substance.

Isotrading does not exceed this import amount and will therefore not be required to register.





We have examined our processes to ensure that we can support our customers in fulfilling their obligations under these directives. We address our customer's needs by procuring product to the precise specifications.

Although it is the customer's responsibility to accurately outline product specifications, we will always strive to assist in gathering necessary information to supply the required product.

We are unable to assert or certify the chemical properties of the components in terms of RoHS / REACH compliance. The responsibility for declaring chemical properties and ensuring RoHS / REACH compliance lies with the component manufacturer. We will inform customers of the RoHS / REACH status of the product at the time of quotation.
